



STAND A CHANCE TO WIN A BAKKIE

COMPETITION RULES:

1. By entering the competition entrants agree to abide by the rules and conditions of the competition.
2. This competition is open to legal residents of the Republic of South Africa, who are customers and punting in the Republic of South Africa, who are 18 years or older, except the employees, directors, members, partners, agents or consultants of Phumelela Gaming and Leisure Limited, Betting World (Pty) Ltd ("Betting World") or Kenilworth Racing (Pty) Ltd and their respective advertising and promotional agencies, media and PR agencies, as well as the immediate family members, consultants, directors and associates of such organizations and persons..
3. The competition will commence on 16 February 2018 and will run until midnight on 11 March 2018. No late entries will be accepted.
4. How to enter:
 - 4.1 To stand a chance to win a bakkie
 - 4.1.1 Take any soccer bet at any TAB store; and;
 - 4.1.2 To qualify write your name, ID and cell phone number on the back of the winning ticket receipt or losing bet ticket which will constitute your entry into the competition; and put it into the competition box in store.
5. Winners will be selected by random draw in accordance with the following procedure:
 - 5.1 All TAB stores will participate in the random draw on a store by store basis;
 - 5.2 All stores will be drawn at random which will mean that anyone who entered at that store will stand a chance to win;
 - 5.3 TAB will host a broadcast from the winning store;
 - 5.4 The entry tickets within the store drawn will be entered into a random manual draw mechanism whereby 1 ticket will be selected;



- 5.5 The winner will be drawn at random and the ticket will be validated based on ID, bet type (i.e. soccer bets only);
- 5.6 The winner must be in store to claim the prize failing which he will be disqualified and another winner will be drawn;
- 5.7 A representative of the Winner of the vehicle needs to present a valid driver's licence to redeem the prize.
6. The winners will be required to present his/her identification document (or passport) when claiming the prize. Should a person who is either under 18 years of age or not a legal resident of the Republic of South Africa be drawn, they will be disqualified from winning and a new draw will take place.
7. TAB will do the prize handover on the day of the draw at the store which is drawn.
8. TAB reserves the right to cancel the competition for any reason whatsoever.
9. In the event the winner is unable to accept the prize for any reason whatsoever, the winner shall forfeit the prize.
10. The prize excludes any other expenses incurred by the entrant when participating in this competition.

will not be entitled to any payment or other remuneration for such publicity or otherwise.
